## MINUTES OF MEETING PORTOFINO ISLES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

#### FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Roll Call

Mr. Winkeljohn called the roll and stated we have a quorum.

#### **SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS**

Approval of the Minutes of the October 10, 2017 Meeting

Mr. Winkeljohn: The minutes from the October 10th meeting have been circulated, if those are in order, a motion to approve would be in order.

On Motion by Mr. Azcona seconded by Mr. Willemstyn with all in favor, the Minutes of the October 10, 2017 Meeting were approved.

#### THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Update on Wall and Fence Project

Mr. Winkeljohn: We have a couple of other action items where one of our Board members might have to leave shortly, so I'm going to table item No. 3 and move on to the next item.

#### FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Engagement Letter with Berger, Toombs, Elam, Gaines & Frank to perform the Audit for Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2017

Mr. Winkeljohn: Item No. 4 does need an authorization from the Board, it's the auditor, and you all remember when we did the audit selection process we ranked Berger, Toombs as the #1 selectee but the Board asked that staff contact them and review the history of our audit and the complications with the Portofino Court bond and how that was handled. So I spoke to TJ Gaines, who is a principal in the firm at length, he mentioned that he's done audits for firms, replacing Grau & Associates and he handles the SPE with a 3-party joint agreement like we have very differently than Grau & Associates. He mentioned he would incorporate that document and the logic of it and make statements and present the audit in a more understandable way in terms of the reality of the health of one side of the community and the lack of health in activity under the SPE. So with that assurance that he was going to be very aware of that and incorporate in those thoughts, I felt that he met the standard that we asked for and I recommend that we authorize and see how he does with an audit.

Mr. Duncan: How long did it take for him to get back to you?

Mr. Winkeljohn: Part of that was probably my fault, I was calling Berger, who is one of the principals who really doesn't deal with CDD audits, it was really TJ Gaines who oversaw it and I mistakenly contacted the wrong auditor, and that's why I didn't hear back from Berger, but the day I reached out to the right person, he called me back and was right on top of it.

#### December 12, 2017

#### **Portofino Isles CDD**

Mr. Duncan: Did you feel that he was responsive, that he understood our needs?

Mr. Winkeljohn: Yes sir, I totally felt that way.

Mr. Duncan: Ok.

Mr. Winkeljohn: So I just need a motion to authorize execution.

Mr. Azcona: So from a legal aspect we determined that we could not separate it, right?

Mr. Winkeljohn: Well it's one tax ID number, so the audit has to incorporate all activities under that tax ID number, but it was really the issue of handling and describing the separation really.

Mr. Azcona: As described as good as possible to try to separate both entities.

Mr. Winkeljohn: Right.

Mr. Duncan: Last month, we had the discussion and as a result of that discussion we said it would be too expensive even to attempt to go through a legal separation and we would not gain any big advantages. So as a result of that, I think the discussion led to a conclusion that we just have to be more specific in the audit explaining the real situation and include the agreement.

Mr. Winkeljohn: Right, that 3-party agreement.

Mr. Duncan: And at the same time, if I remember correctly, I thought it through and you should pursue to really find out what the situation is after 7 years or more, and if there is any outcome.

Mr. Knight: Well I talked to Lerner & Associates who are the managers handling this property, and there's a couple of issues with it, one is still the market, there's a problem with townhomes marketwise, and they're still trying to find a developer or a builder to come in and finish building the community. A couple of problems is the fact that the declarant, or the holder of the declarant's rights under the community documents is the guy that's over there and owns those townhomes, and he's not negotiating and giving that up, so any builder who would want to come in here and buildout the project has to deal with him, and he's leveraging that to some extent, so it's an obstruction to the development of the property. Any builder that comes in would

want to be able to control their own destiny there so that's an issue. The market is an issue. The debt and the delinquent tax certificates and all that, that's a problem too. So there are several problems that they've been facing over the years trying to do something. They would love to get rid of that property, and the SPE, the bondholders would love to find a buyer and sell that property, and whenever I run into any builders that I know that might be interested I always mention that property and some of them actually have come and looked at it, but nobody has been interested in building it yet. So that's the ultimate solution is to get someone to build out that project.

Mr. Duncan: The Board also discussed and asked Paul to put the maintenance in the taxes.

Mr. Winkeljohn: Which is what we're doing, we've been doing that for a while.

Mr. Duncan: I thought that was not the best decision.

Mr. Knight: Well it cuts both ways, you put them on the tax that makes the tax bill even bigger for those lots, and anybody interested in buying the certificates, they end up in the county's hands because if somebody buys them and the county ends up with them, after a couple of years they can apply for a tax deed, and I think they are. I think they're starting to move them to the tax deed process, so that may solve some of the problem because that will get rid of all the taxes that are on there because whoever buys the tax deed gets it free and clear of all the liens, including the lien for debt, and the lien for O&M for that year anyway.

Mr. Duncan: But as a part of these taxes, if they are repaid, we are repaid a small portion of it.

Mr. Knight: That's right, that's the good side, the positive side.

Mr. Duncan: Ok, the last part of it is that, the lakes adjacent to that problem are ours also, and our maintenance, and if you have a baby you cannot take care of half of it. So we have a responsibility that actually is a liability.

Mr. Winkeljohn: Absolutely, so you can, that the entire system is integrated, so it's a share, as well as the roadways and other factors.

#### December 12, 2017

#### Portofino Isles CDD

Mr. Knight: And that system is the drainage basin for the area, for the shopping center, for all the residential around here and this District gets water management fees from the city to help pay the expenses of doing that, and that's the reason because it serves as the drainage basin for the area around it.

Mr. Winkeljohn: So for this purpose though, are there any other questions on approving the audit selection firm and we'll see what we get, hopefully it will be accurate the way we believe.

On Motion by Mr. Azcona seconded by Mr. Willemstyn with all in favor, accepting the engagement letter with Berger, Toombs, Elam, Gaines & Frank to perform the audit for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017 and authorizing the proper District officials to execute the document was approved.

Mr. Winkeljohn: The other action item that I need you for, before we lose quorum would be the financial reports. All candidates shall qualify for individual seats in accordance with Section 99.061, Florida Statutes, and must also be qualified electors of the District. A qualified elector is any person at least 18 years of age who also is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of the State of Florida and of the District, and who is registered to vote with the St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections. Campaigns shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 106, Florida Statues.

The District has two seats up for election, specifically seat #1 and seat #5. Each seat carries a four-year term of office. Elections are nonpartisan and will be held at the same time as the general election on November 6, 2018, in the manner prescribed by law for general elections.
